ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Applicants must possess one of the following qualifications:

I. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as accepted by the Senate.

ii. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and can be accepted, subject to a rigorous internal assessment.

OR

iii. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the Senate and with relevant working experience, subject to a rigorous internal assessment.

OR

iv. A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the HEP Senate and without relevant working experience, subject to passing pre-requisite courses.

v. other equivalent/related qualifications to a Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) recognised by the Malaysian Government

vi. Minimum Diploma with Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) pathway, which offers a flexible enrolment route for professionals based on their work experience and prior learning achievements (for domestic applicants only).

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS:

- · International English Language Testing Services (IELTS), a minimum overall score of 6.0.
