ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must possess one of the following qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree in the field of Traffic Safety Management or related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 or equivalent, as accepted by the HEP Senate; or
- A bachelor's degree in the field of Traffic Safety Management or related fields or equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 and not meeting CGPA of 2.75, can be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment; or
- A bachelor's degree in the field of Traffic Safety Management or related fields or equivalent with minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in the relevant field and rigorous internal assessment.
- Candidates without a qualification in the related fields or relevant working experience must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the HEP and meet the minimum CGPA based on (i) to (iii).
