



Minimum requirements

- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as accepted by the Senate. OR
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and can be accepted, subject to a rigorous internal assessment. OR
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in nonrelated □elds with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the Senate and with relevant working experience, subject to a rigorous internal assessment. OR
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in nonrelated fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the HEP Senate and without relevant working experience, subject to passing pre-requisite courses. OR
- other equivalent/related qualifications to a Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) recognised by the Malaysian Government OR
- Minimum Diploma with Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) pathway, which offers a flexible enrolment route for their professionals based on experience and prior learning achievements (for domestic applicants only).

All international candidates who have graduated from degree programs where English was not the medium of instruction must meet the English Language Proficiency requirements as accepted by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia, by obtaining a minimum score of:

- TOEFL iBT (Test of English as a Foreign Language - Internet-Based Test): 60
