



In 1995, the then Prime Minister, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad and a delegation from Malaysia made a working visit to Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and endorsed the establishment of university modelled after MIT. An agreement was signed in January 1997 to establish the Malaysia University of Science and Technology (MUST).
