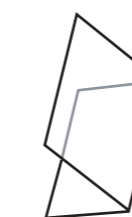

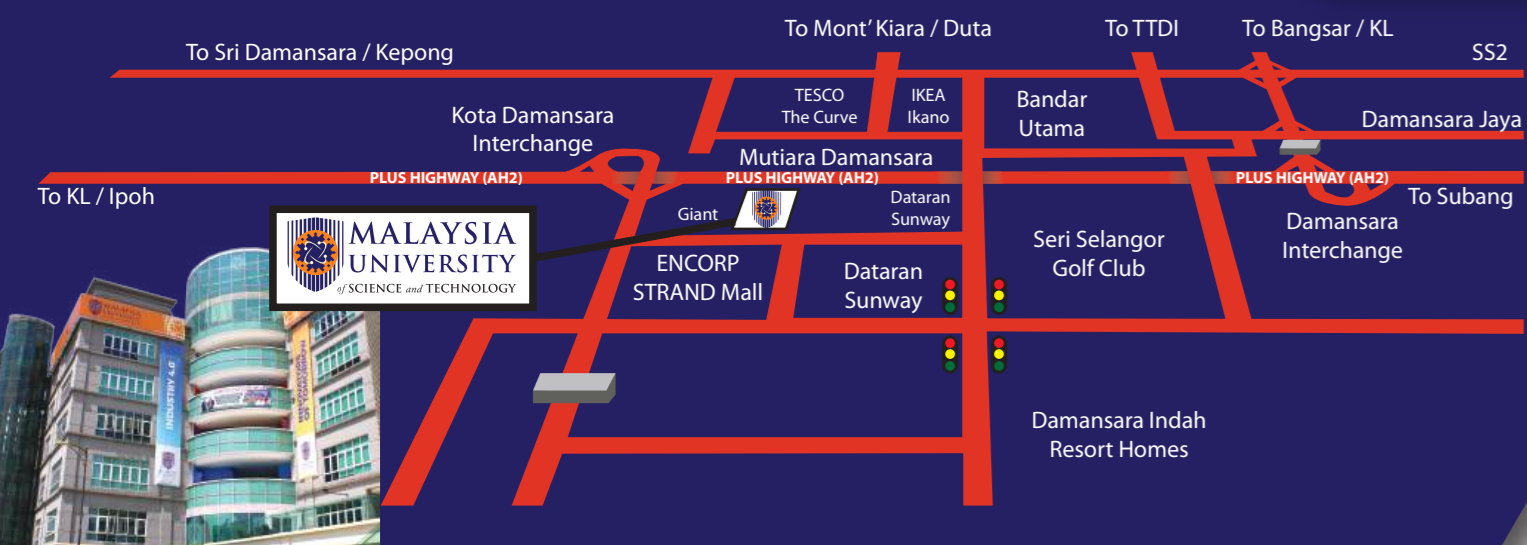

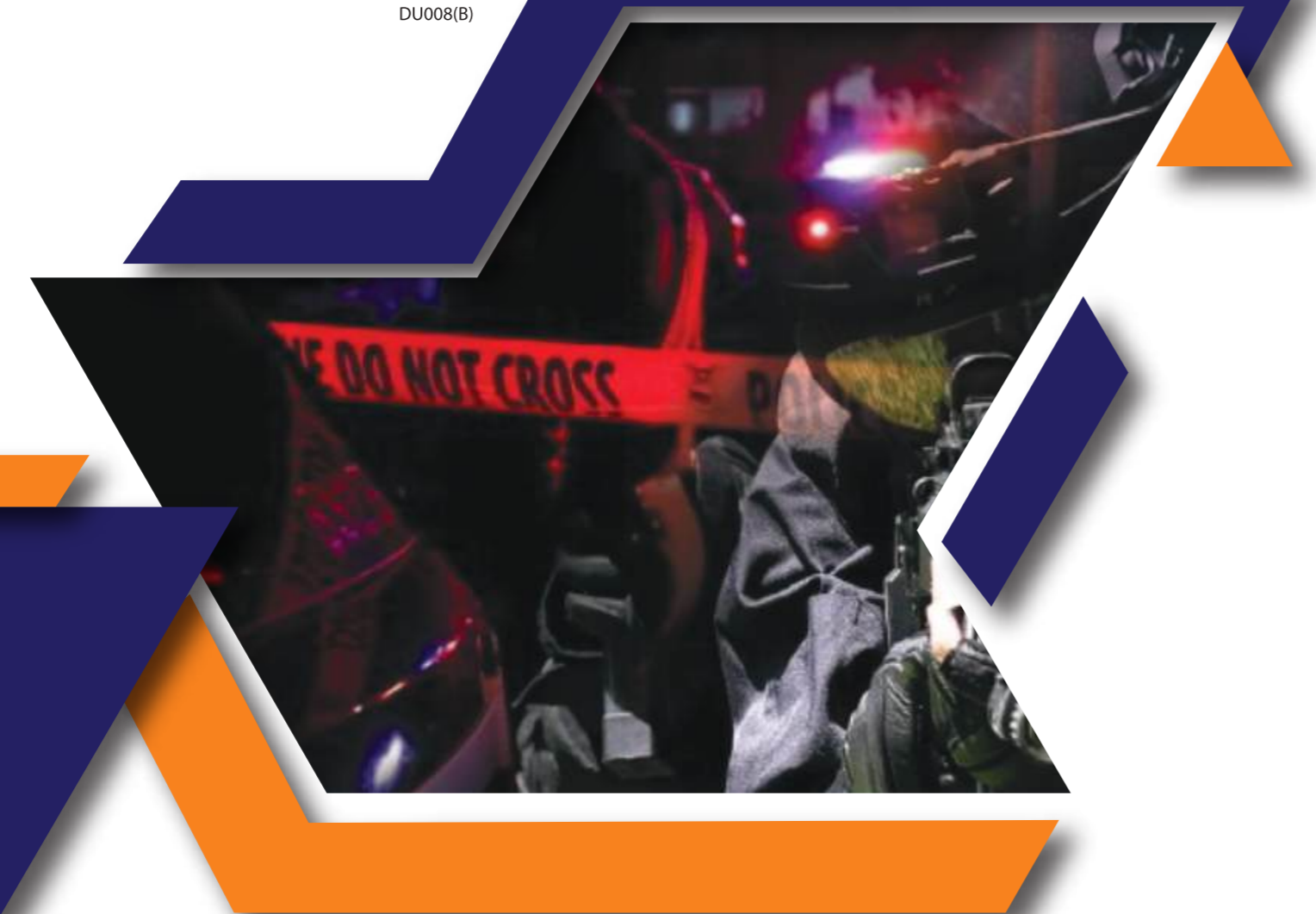

Entry Requirements

- A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) or its equivalent, with a minimum of Grade C in **TWO subjects** (GPA 2.00); OR
- A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Jayyid; OR
- Matriculation/Foundation or its equivalent, with a minimum CGPA of 2.00; OR
- A Diploma or its equivalent, with a minimum CGPA of 2.00; OR
- Diploma Kemahiran Malaysia (DKM)/Diploma Vokasional Malaysia (DVM) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 subjected to HEP Senate/Academic Board's approval; OR
- Diploma Lanjutan Kemahiran Malaysia (DLKM) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 subjected to HEP Senate/Academic Board's approval; OR
- Other relevant and equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Government.

ENGLISH COMPETENCY REQUIREMENT (INTERNATIONAL STUDENT)

Achieve a grade in the MUET or any English competency test equivalent to a High B1 in the CEFR.
